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## Ashlar stones of the district Saalfeld-Rudolstadt (part 3)

## **Abstract**

In the northern part of the district Saalfeld-Rudolstadt sand- and limestones of Younger Paleozoic and Triassic age were excavated in small stone quarries. Until the beginning of the  $20^{th}$  century they were used as broken, cut and building stones. From middle age to the end of the  $19^{th}$  century limestones of Werra (Zechstein 1, area Saalfeld-Könitz) and Leine sequence (Zechstein 3, area Königstein) were being important. Limestones of Unterer Muschelkalk ("Terebratelzone", area Teichel) were widly used till 1940.
